Auto Theft has historically been the focus of the FBI, as a dangerous gateway crime. As a result of this duty, he was named the FBI coordinator for the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS) which was established to address on a national basis, both automotive safety, title fraud and automobile theft.
